LGBTQ older adults are more likely to have poorer mental health: 31% of LGBT elders have symptoms of depression-2 to 3 times higher than the general geriatric population; 39% report having suicidal ideation at some point in their lives. Among the transgender elderly, 48% report symptoms of depression and 71% report a history of suicidal ideation.
