They found that cooperative learning produced greater academic achievement than both competitive learning and individualistic learning across the studies, exhibiting a mean weighted effect size of 0.54 when comparing cooperation and competition and 0.51 when comparing cooperation and individualistic learning. In essence, these results indicate that cooperative learning increases student academic performance by approximately one-half of a standard deviation when compared to non-cooperative ...

The results showed that the overall effects of cooperative learning on achievement were clearly positive in 72% of the comparisons whereas only 15% favoured control groups with 13% recording no significant differences. These findings led Slavin to conclude that cooperative learning can be an effective strategy for increasing student achievement.
